

"Thanks for all your help, we would love to meet up with you again someday," said Mr and Mrs Maclaurin.




"If you want you can come to my house with me now and I could serve you some afternoon tea," offered Ro'Nicholas.




Chapter 7: Going home



Chapter 10: The Cure




30 long minutes later
