Checklist

If it's good enough for Santa Claus, it's good enough for us. Here's a list we've made that you can check twice. Print it out and you'll be sure not to miss any of the important steps

HAVE YOU...	YES WE HAVE!
Printed out this checklist	
Made sure your story is required length - within word count for your division	
Written your story focussing on the FIVE parameters you were given	
Used ALL of the random words you were given without changing them	
Written your story with an Australian theme or setting	
Written your story so it is appropriate for 10-16 year olds	
Created a front cover that is illustrated and includes book title and team name	
Included illustrations throughout your story	
Made sure your story is legible and easy to read	
Printed the Parameter form downloaded on your writing day	
Made sure that the Parameter form is the next page after your cover page	
Included the Copyright page after the Parameter form	
Illustrated a back cover for your book	
Included a blurb on your back cover giving a short summary of the story	
Included the recommended reading age for your story on your back cover	
Bound or stapled your final copy together including front and back covers and all the pages	
Checked to make sure your book can be opened easily for the judges to read	
Optional extras	
If you are using chapters – has each chapter got a title?	
Are you including page numbers? If so are all your pages numbered?	
Are you including reviews for your book? If so, have you included these on your back cover?
